FASB Staff Issues for Comment a Proposed Taxonomy Implementation Guide, Boolean, Fixed List, and Extensible Enumeration Elements

The Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) staff recently issued a proposed Taxonomy Implementation Guide, <u>Boolean</u>, <u>Fixed List</u>, <u>and Extensible Enumeration Elements</u> (the proposed Guide), based on the 2024 GAAP Financial Reporting Taxonomy (Taxonomy). The proposed Guide describes when and how to use the Boolean, Fixed List, and Extensible Enumerations elements and illustrates appropriate use cases for each of these element types.
